Understanding Federal Stimulus Funds

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act established the Education Stabilization Fund (ESF), allocating \$30.75 billion to the U.S. Department of Education.

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act added an additional \$81.88 billion to the ESF, and the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act later contributed over \$170 billion to the ESF.

The ESF is composed of three primary emergency relief funds:


