

After receiving grants in 2017 to upgrade tech infrastructure, Azhar Ahmad's primary goal was to find a sustainable and teacher-friendly solution at East Ramapo Central School District. Across the district, many East Ramapo staff and its 9,000 students were experiencing software limitations on interactive whiteboards and projectors, stifling lesson interactivity.

With ActivInspire[®] Software, Higgins has adopted popular tools such as the timer, dice, and magic ink to scaffold an active learning environment. During whole group instruction, Higgins utilizes the desktop annotate feature to illustrate key concepts. To build student confidence, Higgins regularly invites her kids to the panel for hands-on practice with the software's math tools. For blended-learning classrooms at East Ramapo, using layers to create drag and drop activities brings interactivity to facilitate differentiated instruction.

In addition to ActivInspire, utilizing ClassFlow's cloud-based software has given Higgins added flexibility to craft a more immersive lesson experience. As a virtual exit ticket tool, Higgins has volunteer students live cast discussion responses from Chromebook devices onto ActivPanel. Integrating Screen Share as a positive interaction has promoted a strong sense of digital citizenship among her students.

Ahmad highlighted the importance of differentiated professional development (PD) to navigate a clear path toward effective tech integration.
